

63/554. Financing of the United Nations Mission in Ethiopia and Eritrea

At its 79th plenary meeting, on 7 April 2009, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Fifth Committee,⁸¹ having considered the report of the Secretary-General on the financing of the United Nations Mission in Ethiopia and Eritrea⁸² and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,⁸³

(a) Endorsed the conclusions and recommendations contained in the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,⁸³ and requested the Secretary-General to ensure their full implementation;

(b) Approved the donation of assets of the Mission with an inventory value of 1,398,500 United States dollars and a corresponding residual value of 421,800 dollars to the Government of Ethiopia;

(c) Also approved the donation of assets of the Mission with an inventory value of 6,911,400 dollars and corresponding residual value of 1,967,900 dollars to the African Union in support of the African Union Mission in Somalia;

(d) Decided to keep under review during its sixty-third session the item entitled "Financing of the United Nations Mission in Ethiopia and Eritrea".

63/557. Closed peacekeeping missions

At its 93rd plenary meeting, on 30 June 2009, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Fifth Committee:⁸⁴

(a) Decided to return two thirds of the credits available in the account of the United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observation Mission to the Government of Kuwait in the amount of 996,800 United States dollars;

(b) Also decided to continue to consider the updated financial position of closed peacekeeping missions during its sixty-fourth session.
